Translation of the RecoVET project results into the respective national languages finalised

In autumn 2023, the project team focused on translating all project results into the partners' national languages. As part of this intensive and challenging work, all elements of the online tool were translated. This included the translation of the Videoscribe-videos and podcasts as well as the translation of the additional media units. The RecoVET manual was also translated, resulting in the four original versions of the manual. The toolbox was also finalised and translated into the four languages to act as support material for the project target group.
